Events:

- Wings of Hope: We would like to remind you about the ongoing Wings of Hope event, Breast Cancer Awareness Fundraising, which started on Tuesday, October 10th and will continue to Thursday, October 26th. We encourage BPS learners to contribute 1 BHD per feather bundle. Please send the money with your child to their BCT teacher. Learners are also welcome to contribute more than one bundle if they wish to do so. For more information, please refer to the letter sent out this week.
